



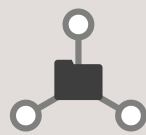

RushFiles

RushFiles is a Danish company, dedicated to develop a true file server alternative that gives corporate users the capability to share data with others and at the same time let the IT admins remain in control of the corporate data.

Technical strengths

- Maximum file size: unlimited
- Enabling access to all corporate data (TB of data on GB device)
- RDS / VDI compatible desktop APP
- Private encryption key for data on cloud
- Use of Hybrid storage locations
- Known data location

Pricing

€60 per company per month
- Unlimited users
 - 1TB storage
 - Unlimited features

Legal strength

Data in RushFiles is always stored on a known location (at the local service provider) making it possible for any company to remain compliant even if sensitive data is stored.



One Drive for business is a file sharing platform that is tightly integrated into Office 365 since Sharepoint. Sharepoint isn't a fileserver platform but a workflow processing / intranet tool, Onedrive is not a real alternative to an on-premise fileserver.

Technical limitations

- Maximum support for 20.000 files
- Maximum file size 10 GB
- No private encryption key for data on cloud
- No encryption of data on client device
- Does not offer local on-premise storing of data
- Microsoft recommends not using desktop sync apps if more than one person have access to the data

Prices

- OneDrive is not sold for companies as a separate product, only bundled with Office 365.
- Per user: €10,70 per month

Legal challenges

For sensitive data OneDrive can only be used if the end-user signs the following special agreements directly with MS:

- Data Processing Agreement
- EU Standard Contractual Clauses



Box Business is an enterprise file sync and sharing (EFSS) platform, that allows users in companies to share and collaborate around the corporate data. Box is recognized by Gartner and others as the leader in the EFSS space.

Technical limitations

- Maximum file size 5 GB
- Maximum file versions: 50
- No private encryption key for data on cloud
- Requires sync to be enabled on Desktop
- Does not offer local on-premise storing of data
- Requires users device to have storage available for all data the user have access to

Pricing

- €12 per user per month (minimum 3 users) – unlimited fair usage storage
- Minimum €36 per month.

Legal challenges

All data is stored in the US and Box is a US company, making it impossible / illegal for EU based companies to use Box service for sensitive data.



Dropbox is the domination consumer file sharing platform with more the 300M users. Even though Dropbox is trying to enter the EFSS market they have huge challenges getting traction. Tight security and control seems not to be an important factor. Using the same platform for consumer file sharing and secure corporate file sharing does not seem ideally.

Technical limitations

- Maximum file size 10 GB
- No private encryption key for data on cloud
- Requires sync to be enabled on Desktop
- Does not offer local on-premises storing of data
- Unknown data location
- Requires users device to have storage available for all data the user have access to
- Requires all users to purchase storage to access all shared data

Pricing

- Free for private use including 2 GB storage
- €12 per user per month (minimum 5 users) – including 1T storage
- Minimum €60 per month.
- All users need to purchase storage in order to share data
